**Statement of Qualifications
Appraisal Review Board**

In order to be considered as a candidate for appointment to the Appraisal Review Board, by the Local Administrative District Judge, please complete the Statement of Qualifications.

To serve on the Appraisal Review Board, you must have lived in the Guadalupe Appraisal District for at least two years before taking office. Training is required annually and is conducted by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts. Leadership positions are encouraged to have background in law and or property appraisal.

You may not serve on the board if you are:

- a person who holds some other paid public office. The Texas Constitution does not allow a person to hold more than one paid public office simultaneously.
- a member of the board of directors, an officer, or employee of the Guadalupe Appraisal District, an employee of the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts, or a member of the governing body, officer or employee of a taxing unit in the Guadalupe Appraisal District.
- related within the second degree by consanguinity or affinity, as determined under Chapter 573, Government Code, to an individual who is engaged in the business of appraising property for use in proceedings with the Guadalupe Appraisal District or of representing property owners for compensation in proceedings with the Guadalupe Appraisal District for which the Appraisal Review Board is established, or in the business of appraising property for property tax purposes in the appraisal district,
- a person who contracts with the appraisal district or with a taxing unit in the appraisal district,
- a person who has substantial interest in a business entity which contracts with the appraisal district or taxing unit within the appraisal district. Substantial interest is defined as either combined ownership by the member or the member's spouse of at least 10% of the voting stock or shares of the business, or service by the member or member's spouse as a partner, limited partner, or officer in the business entity.
- owns property on which delinquent taxes have been owed to a taxing unit for more than 60 days after the date the individual knew or should have known of the delinquency, unless delinquent taxes, penalty and interest are being paid under an installment agreement under Section 33.02, or a suit to collect the delinquent taxes is deferred or abated under Section 33.06 or 33.065.
- is related within the third degree by consanguinity or within the second degree by affinity, as determined under Chapter 573, Government Code, to a member of the Appraisal District's Board of Directors.
- a person who resides in an appraisal district established for a county having a population of more than 100,000, and have served for all or part of three previous terms as a board member or auxiliary board member or is a former member of the board of directors, officer, or employee of the Guadalupe Appraisal District; or if the person served as a member of the governing body or officer of a taxing unit until the fourth anniversary of the date the person ceased to be a member or officer; or if the person appeared before the appraisal review board for compensation during the two year period preceding the date the person is appointed.

If appointed to the A.R.B., the term is a two year commitment which commences January 1st, and ends December 31st of the following year. A.R.B members may not participate in any hearings until the required A.R.B. training course authorized by the Comptroller of Public Accounts, or subsequent continuing education requirements are completed. The Comptroller will issue a certification acknowledging completion of the required training.

Chapter 6 of the Texas Tax Code that specifically outlines eligibility requirements in order to be considered for appointment to the Appraisal Review Board, as well as other topics related to the potential appointment.

Statement of Acknowledgment by Applicant
