

NOTICE TO ALL VISITORS OF APPRAISAL DISTRICT OFFICES

The Guadalupe Appraisal District welcomes the continual improvement and progress, we as a community, have made in combatting COVID-19. Governor Abbott's decision to rescind his previous Executive Order (GA-34), effective today, removes state mandated requirements related to face coverings but does allow for individual businesses or entities to still require a face covering to enter their premises.

In considering our operational objectives to timely complete our annual reappraisal activities, process submitted exemption applications, and facilitate available administrative remedies for property owners appealing their 2021 valuations; The **Guadalupe Appraisal District will require those entering our facilities to still wear a face covering**. If you enter one of our two lobbies without a face covering, you will be asked to do so. You are ***welcomed to choose not to*** but will be asked to exit our building and ***remotely submit your documents or questions*** for assistance. We have several options available; drop boxes, fax, email, or regular mail.

We apologize for any inconvenience these continued preventive practices may cause those in the short-term. We will **reevaluate** these practices following the completion of our 2021 certification process, **July 25, 2021**.
